Target List: The target list and any other information will be published on the Bowbrook Archers website and IANSEO on Wednesday 20th November prior to the tournament.

Refreshments: Hot & Cold refreshments will be available on the day, cash and card payments both accepted.

Photography: Those who wish to take photographs at this event are to register with the tournament organiser on arrival. PARENTS AND GUARDIANS: please be aware that by entering your child you are also accepting that photographs may be taken at the event by authorised photographers.

Music: Music will be played during the event at volumes appropriate to competitive archery, any issues please inform the TO.

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- Data protection: The following information will be collected and shared with tournament organisers, scoring systems and other competitors (for example, Target Lists and Results may be published):  
First and Surnames, Gender, Bow Style, Date of Birth / Age category, Email, Address, telephone number, Club, County/Region, Round, Disabled Y/N, Disability info if necessary).
- Disabled archers: Should notify the organiser of the nature of their disability and any special requirements, e.g. use of wheelchair or stool for shooting and/or the need to remain on the shooting line. If you are visually impaired, do you need a spotter? The organisers will do their best to accommodate you and meet your requirements.
